You are receiving this email because you are a past supporter of Village HopeCore in Kenya. As a board we are most grateful for your support. Because of you, HopeCore accomplished incredible things and has grown and thrived over the past 15 years.

The medical program recently provided clean drinking water for 181 schools and 45,000 students, provided mosquito nets for malaria prevention for school children and their families and is now setting up a child/maternal health care clinic to support schools in the Chogoria district. Many major organizations around the world, including Planned Parenthood International, Rotary Foundation, Segal Foundation and Helping Hands have generously assisted funding of these projects.

When the HopeCore micro loan program started 15 years ago we loaned \$300 per participant. In today's dollars we had to increase the loan amount to \$800 to help loan families escape poverty. **WE NEED YOUR HELP!** Unless we get additional funding, fewer families will benefit from micro-loans.
